## VISIO DIVINA

Desire: to worship God in the beauty of His creation

**Definition**: In the practice of visio divina we intentionally seek God by praying in His created nature

**Scripture**: "Since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities-his eternal power and divine nature-have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse." (Romans 1:20)

## God-given fruit:

- gratitude
- ability to receive what the seasons of life give us
- holy imagination
- growing appreciation for the beauty of the earth and the glory of the skies

- 2. What part of God's creation inspires you to pray the most?
