Desire: To align myself, while walking in particular places, with Jesus and His intercession for the kingdom to come.

Definition: Prayer walking is a way of physically walking with Jesus through places (hospitals, homes, businesses, churches, schools, playgrounds, housing projects, service agencies, counties, countries, etc.) that you are concerned about. From the vantage point of proximity, prayers for the kingdom to come are offered to God.

Scripture: Colossians 4:2-4 Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart. 3 Pray for us, too, that God will give us many opportunities to speak about his mysterious plan concerning Christ. That is why I am here in chains. 4 Pray that I will proclaim this message as clearly as I should.

God-given fruit:

- Gaining the perspective of Jesus for a place or group of people
- Praying with purpose where you are at

Reflection Questions:

- 1. What is it like for you to pray, listening for what God's heart for a particular request might be?
- 2. How does moving or being still affect the way you pray?

Spiritual Exercises:

- 1. Spend some time walking with other believers through your workplace. Pray for your colleagues, the custodial help, the customers, the delivery people, the kitchen staff. Offer yourself to be Jesus's hands and heart in this place.
- 2. Walk through your home and church in the company of Jesus. Pray for each room and what happens there. How would recognizing Jesus's presence there reorient your interaction?
